The Consultation Process


The consultation ran from 25th June 2025, to 26th July 2025. The process included the following:

- Public notice placed in *The Times*
- Public notice placed in *The Grimsby Telegraph*
- Consultation document issued to all students, staff and parents/carers
- Consultation document distributed to 12 MPs, all secondary schools and colleges and local authorities in North East Lincolnshire, North Lincolnshire and Lincolnshire
- Department for Education and the Secretary of State.
