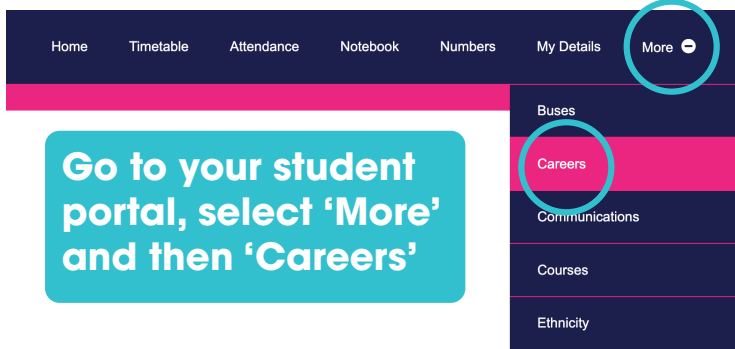
## Local Events

## **Doctors**

There are over 50 different specialities to choose from. Everything from anaesthesia to tropical medicine. All of them making a difference to people's lives. Being a doctor means you'll receive training from leading universities and teaching hospital trusts across the UK. You'll also enjoy a competitive salary, one of the most generous pension schemes in the UK, and discounts at shops, restaurants and more.

### What are my career options as a doctor?

As well as specialising in one of the many [roles as a doctor](#), there are a range of other career opportunities in medicine. Doctors work in all areas of healthcare providing you with endless career possibilities. As part of your medical training, you'll have the opportunity to try out many of these fantastic specialities and then choose the one you would like as your speciality

### What Qualifications do I need and How do I become a doctor?

Your first step is medical school at university. Most graduates then join the NHS Foundation Programme before choosing a speciality such as a general practice or psychiatry

The standard path to becoming a doctor in the UK involves the following academic and practical stages:

#### **1. Pre-University (Secondary Education)**

**GCSEs:** Most medical schools require at least 5 to 7 GCSEs at grades 9-7 (A\* or A), including English Language, Mathematics, and Sciences (Biology, Chemistry, and Physics).

**A-Levels:** You typically need 3 A-levels. Typical offers range from A\*AA to AAA, and Chemistry and/or Biology are almost always mandatory.

**Admissions Tests:** You will be required to sit for the University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT) for almost all standard courses. Some universities might also require the BioMedical Admissions Test (BMAT).

#### **2. Medical Degree**

**Undergraduate (5-6 Years):** The most common route is a 5-year Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS or MBChB).

**Graduate Entry (4-5 Years):** If you already hold a bachelor's degree (typically in a science discipline with a 1st or 2:1), you can apply for an accelerated 4-year Graduate Entry Medicine (GEM) program.

**Foundation/Gateway Year:** If you have high academic grades but lack the required science subjects at A-Level, some universities offer a 6-year course that includes a preliminary foundational year.

#### **3. Postgraduate Training (Post-Graduation)**

**Foundation Programme (2 Years):** After graduating from medical school, you will undertake a mandatory 2-year Foundation Programme of general clinical training in hospitals or GP practices. You are provisionally registered with a licence to practise during your first year and earn full registration once you successfully complete Year 1.

**Specialist or GP Training (3-8+ Years):** After the Foundation Programme, you will undertake further speciality training. Becoming a General Practitioner (GP) takes about 3 years, while training to be a hospital consultant can take 5 to 8 years.

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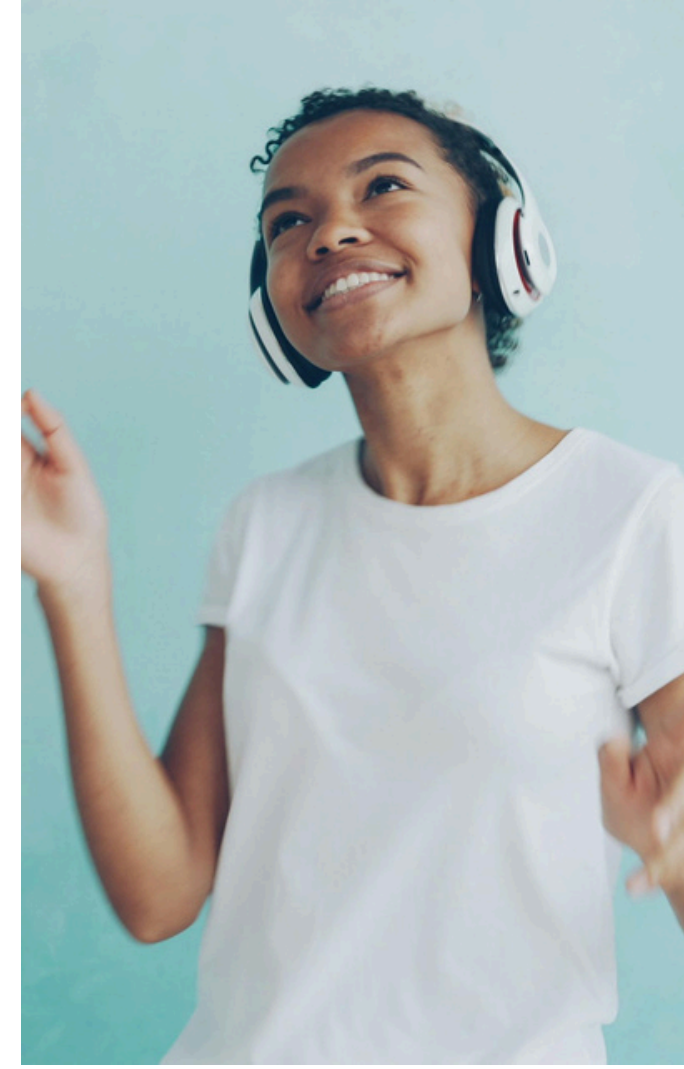
