The workshop will cover key areas of midwifery, including antenatal care, intrapartum care (labour and delivery), and postnatal care. You will find out about the essential qualifications you'll need to pursue a career in midwifery, the application process, and interview tips. We'll also give you an idea of course expectations, clinical placement experiences, and what to expect during your training and beyond. This session is designed to give you the knowledge, insight and inspiration to start your journey towards a career as a student midwife.

This 'Curious About Counselling' workshop will give you a real insight into what counselling is all about. Discover the key skills you need, like listening and empathy, explore the different routes into the profession and what it's like to support others. This interactive workshop will give you insight into careers in this rewarding field.

COMMUNITY EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGY IN NORTH EAST LINCOLNSHIRE

North East Lincolnshire Council

Community Educational Psychologists are often employed by Local Authorities, working with others to try to better understand children and young people, and the environments and experiences that will help them thrive. In this workshop, we will tell you about the training route into Educational Psychology, and we will share a technique with you from the Narrative Therapy approach that we sometimes use to talk with people about their experiences, called the Tree of Life. There will be an opportunity to experience a shortened version of the Tree of Life, as well as to ask questions about career paths and the role itself. We look forward to sharing some of the things we love doing with you!

A DAY IN THE LIFE OF AN ADULT SOCIAL WORKER

Focus

This workshop will give you an insight into the role of a social worker in the adult social care sector and their day-to-day work. It will cover the laws that guide the profession and how they protect people's rights, as well as give information on resources, agencies, and supportive services within the community. You will see how these all work together to improve people's lives, prevent illness and deterioration, and promote wellbeing. You will also look at the routes into the social care field, including the Social Work Academy based in North East Lincolnshire, and explore some of the challenges faced when working in this field. This session will be with a current, practising social worker who will give you a realistic view of what it's really like to work in this rewarding field.

VASCULAR AND NEUROLOGICAL ASSESSMENT

Humber Health Partnership

This workshop will be interactive and give the opportunity to practise using equipment we use daily, such as Dopplers to listen to people's circulation and how we identify issues with this and signs of other conditions, such as diabetes and other foot pathologies. Podiatry involves lower limb specialists who assess and treat conditions relating to the foot and lower limb, which can range from biomechanics, insoles, wound care, and nail surgery. We specialise in assessing and treating individuals with complex needs.

WORKSHOP HOSTS

INTERACTIVE FUTURE MEDICAL STUDENT SESSION: PULSE OXIMETER PRACTICAL

Students take science beyond the classroom in this hands-on session, using medical-grade pulse oximeters to measure how the body responds to exercise. A dynamic and engaging way to explore human biology, data analysis, and real-world health applications.

CARING FOR PEOPLES MENTAL & PHYSICAL HEALTH NEEDS

In this workshop we will guide you through the complexities of caring for people with a range of mental and physical health needs. You will learn about the signs and symptoms of changes in their condition and what skills you need to support your patients. You can ask questions to the facilitators and discover what it means to be a nurse and care for people at their most vulnerable. Have you got what it takes?
